The Baldwins purchased their first Charolais heifers in 1969 and have been building the herd and developing herd genetics ever since. Originally cattle breeders, the Baldwins began raising beef when they decided to market surplus stock themselves. V. Mac is a firm believer that “good grass makes good beef.” Over the years, he has developed a year-round grazing system using a mixture of diverse perennial and winter and summer annual forage plants to ensure his cattle have continual access to high-quality, nutritious and chemical-free grasses throughout all seasons. The Baldwins will receive a commemorative metal farm sign to acknowledge their decade of certification--and their ongoing commitment to high-welfare, sustainable farming.
