Species include dairy cattle, beef cattle, bison, pigs, goats, sheep, chickens (laying hens and broilers), turkeys, geese and ducks. Ability to audit multiple species is required.
- **Crop specialists:** audit farms to verify non-GMO and regenerative farming practices based on AGW's published standards.
- **Regenerative farming specialists:** audit both livestock and crop farms to confirm regenerative farming practices based on AGW's published environmental and social standards.
- **Slaughter specialists:** review slaughter plants that are used by certified farms and conduct annual reviews of plants already recommended by the program based on AGW's published red meat and poultry slaughter guidelines.

- Mass-balance specialists: conduct remote or in-person mass-balance audits of businesses to verify compliance with AGW's distributor and further processor standards.
