NORTH CAROLINA FARMER CELEBRATES 10 YEARS WITH LEADING FARM SUSTAINABILITY CERTIFIER

KENANSVILLE, NC (SEPTEMBER 12, 2023)—Ronald Simmons of Master Blend Family Farms in Kenansville, NC, is celebrating 10 years of certification with Certified Animal Welfare Approved by <u>A</u> <u>Greener World</u> (AGW), the leading animal welfare and sustainability label across North America. Simmons is the third generation to farm the family's land in Duplin County, NC, and his farming journey began in 2012 when his father-in-law considered selling the family farm. Simmons wanted to try raising pigs outdoors on pasture and range, so with the help of his community and research through North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University, North Carolina State University and North Carolina Cooperative Extension, he took over production at Master Blend Family Farms. Simmons achieved Certified Animal Welfare Approved by AGW certification for the pasture-raised pigs in 2013 and since 2015 has focused on niche pork production, growing the farm's production capacity over time. The farm added a general store onsite that sells Master Blend Family Farms pork and a variety of other locally grown products. The business also added a food truck and catering service, and Master Blend Family Farms sells their products to premium restaurants, high-end eateries, and professional sports stadiums across North Carolina and the Southeast.

Simmons believes in raising pork to the highest animal welfare standards and ensuring they offer sustainable solutions for the farming industry. In addition to being a good steward of the land, part of the farm's business model is to ensure that children in the community get exposure to agriculture through farm visits, FFA and 4-H activities. At the time of publication, Simmons has purchased a second farm with the intent of setting up a school for agriculture.

Simmons is rooted in his community, and in 2017, Ron earned the Martin Luther King Jr. Entrepreneur of the Year Award. He was also named the 2018 North Carolina Small Farmer of the Year by the Cooperative Extension Program at NC A&T State University. To acknowledge the decade of Certified Animal Welfare Approved by AGW certification in 2023—and his commitment to high-welfare, sustainable farming, Simmons received a commemorative metal farm sign from A Greener World.

The Certified Animal Welfare Approved by AGW label lets consumers know farm animals are raised outdoors on pasture or range in accordance with the highest animal welfare standards in the U.S. and Canada, using sustainable agriculture methods on an independent farm. Consumer Reports has rated Certified Animal Welfare Approved by AGW as the only "highly meaningful" label for farm animal welfare, outdoor access and sustainability—and the only animal welfare certification in which they have confidence. A recent report from the influential Hartman Group, a leading food and beverage market research company, reveals Certified Animal Welfare Approved by AGW label has the **highest impact** on consumer purchasing behavior of any food label.
